A Tribute to a True Friend



Larc's art and music programs were expanded, and the building overflowed with creativity and shouts of joy on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays throughout the year. As Larc approached the summer months, several students said their first words, took their first steps, and made their first friends...miracles that at one time seemed impossible! Once the summer Extended School Year ended, Larc began planning for a sensory walk, facility dog, and outdoor communications board to give students the ability to communicate while at play.

This fall, with the help of Ainsley's Angels, five of Larc's students used adaptive racing chairs to cross the finish line for the first time at the Cooper Norcross Run the Bridge event. The same month it was announced that Larc was the only school out of 130 private schools to receive three awards for excellence from ASAH, a statewide association. In the final days of 2022, Larc received two new significant grants: one to provide critical transportation in its Adult Program, and the other to fund gaps in insurance coverage so families need not worry about costs when helping their children, walk, talk, and just be kids.

As I consider all of these accomplishments, I am motivated to look past my own challenges in the upcoming year and focus instead on my talents and abilities as those at Larc do. On behalf of the entire Larc Board of Directors. I thank our students, our families, and our staff for showing us courage, determination, and creativity. It has been inspiring watching the many miracles that have been accomplished together in one year. We have seen the possibilities for the future, and they are limitless.
